The Governors and staff are delighted to share the results of Amotherby school's performance in the recently published Performance Tables released by the Department of Education last week. Out of 363 North Yorkshire primary schools Amotherby CP School came 35<sup>th</sup> with 96% of children achieving level 4b or above in reading, writing and maths in the SAT tests (taken June 2015). The results also show the rate of progress and improvement the school has made since 2012.
